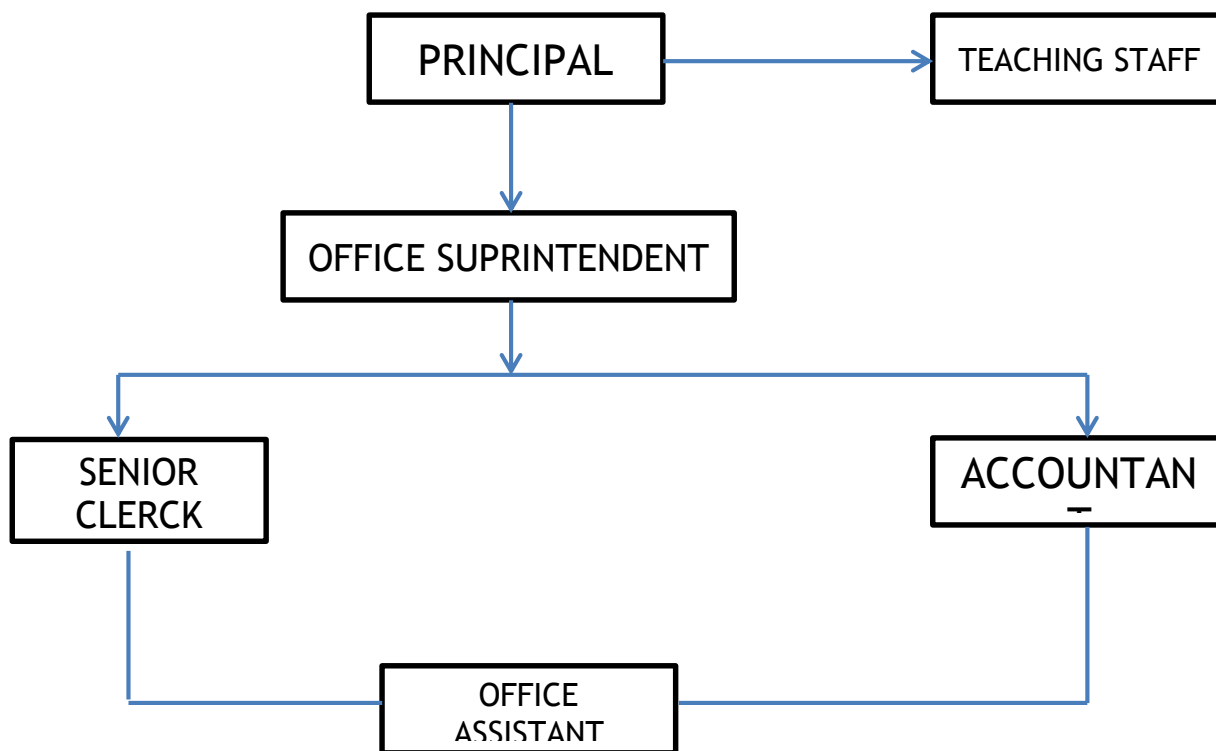
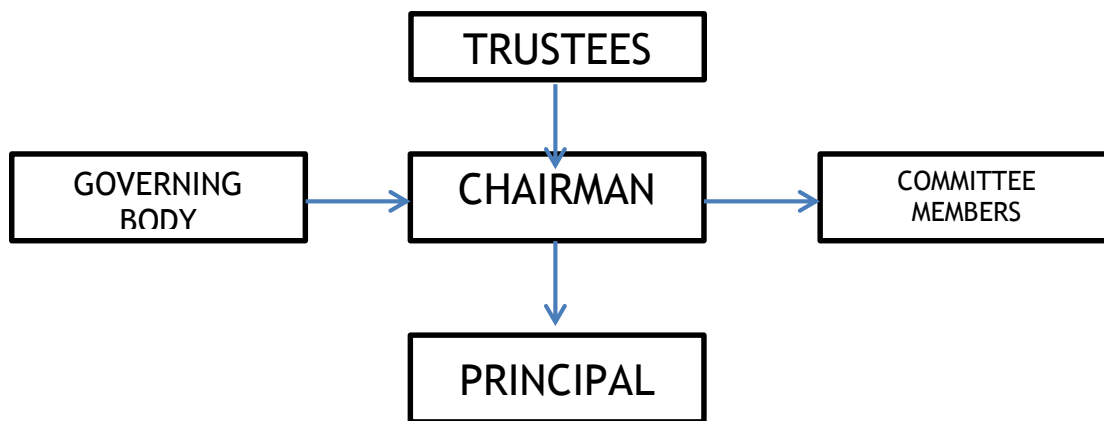

Rules:

2. All complainants should file their grievances either by writing in paper to the committee or by online on the website of the college.
3. The committee will meet at least once in a month to resolve the grievances.
4. To take conclusive decision and submit its recommendations to the deciding authority for removal of alleged grievances.
5. The student/staff shall bring up his grievance in a prescribe format immediately to the grievance cell without fail. The number of grievance settled or pending will be report to the Principal/Director in every month.
